WHAT TO EXPECT AFTER YOUR PET'S VACCINATIONS

It's common for pets to experience mild, short-lasting side effects after receiving a vaccine. Signs start within hours of the vaccination and typically do not persist for more than a few days. This is a normal response by your pet's immune system during the process of developing protective immunity.

COMMON REACTIONS TO PET VACCINES

- MILD FEVER
- SWELLING/ DISCOMFORT AT THE VACCINATION SITE
- DECREASED APPETITE
- DECREASED ACTIVITY

Rare side effects, such as an allergic reaction may occur. Your pet may experience symptoms of a more serious reaction to the vaccine within minutes or hours of the vaccination.

RARE SIDE EFFECTS TO PET VACCINES

- **DIFFICULTY BREATHING**
- REPEATED VOMITING OR DIARRHEA
- HIVES (SKIN IS BUMPY AND ITCHY)
- SWELLING OR PUFFINESS IN OR AROUND THE FACE, NOSE, EYES, OR NECK
- PERSISTENT AND SEVERE COUGHING
